76 DANCE CLUB RATE INCREASE

In a few months it will be time to renew your membership in the 76 Dance Club. Unfortunately there will be some changes that we regret, but nevertheless are necessary. As the New Year rolled over, the 5% increase in hall rent came into play. Our rent is now \$851 each Saturday, which pushes our fixed costs to a little over \$1200 per dance. In past years we have not passed this increase on to dancers, but now we must try to catch up. With 7 years of decreasing attendance and memberships, we are forced to increase the cost of memberships and guest fees. The dance year for the '76 Club ends with the April dance, and the May dance will require a new membership. Fees will be increased as follows:

Prepaid membership will increase from \$75 to \$96.

Regular membership will increase from \$24 to \$30 plus a \$9 admission fee.

Guest fees will increase from \$12 to \$13.

These are hard economic times, which make it doubly regrettable, but if we wish to remain solvent we must take this action.

Membership applications are available in this Newsletter. We encourage all dancers to help our Club by joining and showing support. We have kept costs as low as possible for the past few years and we now feel there is no other solution. This past year every member of the '76 Board has joined as a prepaid member to help with the problem. Hoping to see you all at Arbor.
